

OUR NEW SCHOOL

PROVIDING ACCESS TO EDUCATION IN TANZANIA

High on a mountain overlooking the Serengetti sits the remote village of Olornoyo, Ngorongoro.

With no roads or infrastructure, the community here has very little contact with the outside world ... And, until now, has never had access to education.

We built our new school using local materials and traditional Maasai building methods to provide a safe place for learning.



Our school provides new access to education for a community of over 1,000 people, with a focus on children between the ages of 3 and 11 years old.



Once enhanced, our school will also serve as a centrally accessible community center and collection and storage resource for safe water.








INVEST IN OUR COMMUNITY
